

A brief history of Bergzicht farm no. 105, Windhoek - written by Hendrik Johannes du Plessis  
The farm is located approximately 22km east of Dordabis and spans 4973 hectares. It was previously owned by M.C. Coetzee.

In the Dordabis area, it was customary to issue checks for payment of piecework. The receiver of revenue often exchanged the check at the Dordabis store before coming to make purchases, which sometimes resulted in the store holding onto old, paid checks from the owner.

As a result, the store accumulated several checks from the owner, and all attempts to collect the money failed. Eventually, I drove to the owner to discuss the matter in person, where I received yet another round of promises. After a while I returned and suggested that the owner give me a few head of cattle.

The owner agreed, and we took a ride around the farm.

Bergzicht was surrounded by mountains and hills to the north, northwest, and south. It was otherwise flat, but beautiful. Upon arriving at the house, I turned to my wife, Lida and my mother-in-law, who were visiting, and said, "This is the first farm I'm going to buy."

Time passed on, and Michiel, joined the military, where he sadly lost his life. He was unmarried, and therefore the farm was inherited by his brother, Carel Coetzee.

However, it was not long before Carel's neighbouring farm (from his original farm), Bildah came up for sale, and Carel decided that Bergzicht was too far away and put it on the market.

One day in 1979, I was in Windhoek on business when Carel arrived at the store in Dordabis to tell my wife that he wanted to sell Bergzicht because it was too far away for him.

Typically, I would fill up my truck with gas upon arriving from Windhoek and then unload my goods. That day I got out of the truck, and my wife had the key to the pump. I couldn't remember for sure, but I don't think she even greeted me. Then she said, "Do you want to buy a farm?" and I replied, "First give me a chance to catch my breath!"

She then told him the story, and that evening, we discussed our options. It turned out that we had to take a chance, so I called Carel and asked to meet with him.

We quickly drove over, and Carel asked R30 per hectare for the 4973 hectares, which amounted to R150,000. I knew we could get around with R80,000 without too much trouble, but I needed to come up with the rest...

So we went away to make plans because I had taken an option for 14 days. Carel needed to sell Bergzicht to buy Bildah, and time was short. I came up with a new plan almost every day until I finally said to Carel, "We'll buy it!"

After we signed the purchase agreement, I worked out the rest of the details, and when it was time to pay in 1980, I was able to do so.

That is more or less how things went down. Hannes had a place reserved for him at the University of the Free State in Bloemfontein, but when it looked like we were going to buy Bergzicht, he refused to go to Bloemfontein and said he was only going to Neudam (which is the Namibian Agricultural College). And so, it was.

gegee. Hy het ingewillig en ons het in  
draai op die plaas gery.

Bergzicht het segs op die woorde woord  
westelike en na die suidelike berge' en  
kapspe gehad, weder was dit vlakke en  
dit het gemaak dat ek toe ek by die  
huis kom, vir Lida my eggenote en haar  
Ma wat 'by ons gebly het gesê het: "Wê  
is die eerste plaas wat ek gaan koop"

So het die tyd maar aangelopen  
Magiel het later by die wees mag aan  
gestuit, waar hy sy keur verloor  
het. Hy was ongetrou en sy broer  
Carol het Bergzicht ge-erf.

Wid was eger nie baie dank nie, Toe kom  
gatta, wat aan Carl se Maas gegrens het, in  
die wark. So besluit hy toe Bergzicht is  
te ver en wil dit verkooop Windhoek

Op 'n goeie dag in 1979, was ek Kosdabis  
toe vir besigheid, Toe Carl op Rosdabis  
by hida by die winkel gekom het en  
vir haar se hy wil Bergzicht verkoop  
dies is te ver vir hom.

My gebruik was, as ek met die vrag  
in Windhoek kom, met ek eerste die  
pakkie met petrol en baie daar af. Die  
dag toe ek uit Klein was Ma by met  
die pompe se slentel. Ek kammie out,  
hou nie, maar ek dink sy het my nog  
nie eers gegroet nie, toe se sy. Wel  
is u plaas hoop? Ek se be maar net "   
geel my kans om asem te haal".

So vertel sy my die storie. Wie aand  
het ons koppe by mekaar gesit om te kyk  
hoe ons sake staan. #101 bly be dat  
ons u kans moet vat en so bel ek  
vir Carl en vra hy moet my eerste  
opsie gee of ek hoer kan strom sien.

So gesi so gedraan. Ons ry be so gou  
as moontlik "H973 ha en shy wil R30-00  
per hektaar be. Dis R150,000-00. Mens  
waar shy jy dit. Ek sal so R50,000-00  
kan shy sonder moeite, maar die  
res.

Wel, wel ek het maar gaan plan  
maak, want ek het u opsie sijn 14 dae  
gemeen, want dat hy wel Bullet koop, maar

moet Bergzicht eens verkoop so sya is min.  
Els het amper elke dag met een of ander  
Man gekom en eindelik "mijn Casch gese" @us  
koop.

Ja ons die koop brief getitlen het het ek  
verder die dinge deur gewerk en toe ek moet  
belaal - dit was in 1980 geweest, kon ek dit  
regkry

Dit is min of meer soos ainge gekoop  
het. Hannes se plek was in Bloemfontein  
se Universiteit bespreek maar toe het  
gelyk het asof ons Bergzicht gaan koop  
het hy net gewens of om Bloemfontein  
toe te gaan en gese hy gaan net Pekaam  
toe en so was dit

Ek hoop dit help jou Casch. Se maar  
as daar foute is, dan help ons weer.
